

Lebanon

- All trash to be collected once per week on the same day.
- Limit of six (6) containers weighing no more than forty (40) lbs. each per household.
- Tree limbs over six inches (6") in diameter or three feet (3') in length or otherwise cut to three (3) foot length and tied in bundles.
- Bulky/heavy item pick up. This service is not a part of your regular trash collection, scheduling and fee applies. White goods and heavy trash would include but not be limited to stoves, washers, dryers, furniture, and other items with weights or volumes greater than those allowed in the container limits. Items containing refrigerants, (refrigerators, ac units, freezers, and dehumidifiers) can be taken if CFC's or HCFC's have been properly removed by a licensed technician. Call Ray's at (800) 531-6752 to schedule your pick up (most pick ups can be scheduled on your regular trash collection day). Nominal fee applies.
- Spring and Fall Clean ups (drop off program): These clean-ups give the city residents a chance to clean their property and get rid of household items they no longer want. Spring clean-up is the last Friday and Saturday of April, and the Fall clean-up is the first Friday and Saturday of October. Items can be dropped off at City Street Department.
- Please have all items to the curb by 7:00 AM on your collection day. Pick up will be from 7:00 AM – 4:00PM
- Holiday Schedule: Ray's Trash Service will service regularly on all holidays EXCEPT Christmas Day and New Year's Day. The remaining days following CHRISTMAS DAY and NEW YEAR'S DAY in those weeks will operate on a one day delay.

- Unacceptable trash items include: hot ashes, any liquids, broken concrete, asphalt, building materials, hazardous wastes, animal carcasses or human or animal excretion.
- Unacceptable Trash Items: Hazardous Materials: Any waste designated as "hazardous" by the United States Environmental Protection Agency or appropriate state agency as the same is now in effect or may hereinafter be amended. This term shall also include any flammable/volatile liquids. No paint cans, or items containing Freon. Please contact your local hazardous waste site for details on proper disposal:
